Unofficial Constitution of the Democratic Hunter Empire

<u>Preamble</u>

<u>This version of the Constitution is a simplified version – and not a replacement for</u> – the official Constitution. For the benefit of all, lies the simplicity of life, liberty, and prosperity.

The Democratic Hunter Empire is the full name to which this Constitution unites; "DHE" is an abbreviation and "Hunter's Empire" is the short-possessive version of the Democratic Hunter Empire.

<u>Articles</u>

<u>A</u>rticle I is of Justice, balance, and exceptions. Article II is the central powers such as Head of State. Article III is of decentralized powers such as Parliament and High Council.

<u>Partitions</u>

Head of State is:

Imperator: The President. Consul: The Vice President.

High Council is:

Hunters appointed by Head of State or Plebiscite as a partition of Judiciary or Congress.

Parliament Is:

Active Congress, which is:

- Referendum: All Hunters of the Hunter's Empire.

- Plebiscite: High Council (optionally) and those appointed by Referendums.

- Note: Congress is every Hunter of the Hunter's Empire, which is actually a Referendum. Therefore in most cases Congress and Referendum may be used interchangeably. Ministries Are:

Directed by Ministers, whom: - Are appointed by a governmental body. - May appoint bureaucrats.

<u>Votes</u>

<u>Every 6</u> months or server reset (whichever is longer) every Hunter comes together to vote for the Head of State. The victor of the election is the group (3) who has 10% higher vote verses all other candidates. If the victor is a new Head of State then the old Head of State must make the transition of the new Head of State as seamless as possible, and ministers may help with the Head of State's transitioning.

<u>M</u>ost official voting requires a 2/3 (66%) success vote, which is the default unless the Constitution states otherwise.

<u>Recalls</u>

<u>Recalls are the anti-vote, which take place in a Plebiscite. Recalls remove elected</u> officials from office, and repeal laws or policies under certain circumstances. By default removing elected officials requires the standard 2/3 (66%) voting requirement. The Imperator cannot be recalled by Plebiscite, and Consul(s) require a 3/4 (75%) success vote to be recalled. Recalls against bureaucrats do not require the bureaucrat to had perform an unlawful action.

<u>Head of State</u>

<u>H</u>ead of State is the "executive" body and the powers. Head of State enacts – but does not create – laws. Head of State is the leading army command, most noticeably the Imperator who has the highest power in Head of State. The Head of State delegates land policies and works as the centralized unit of the Hunter's Empire.

Head of State - Emergency Powers

<u>Head of State may use emergency powers during an emergency. Emergency powers</u> grant overrides for limitations, requirements, and other such elevated privileges. Emergency powers are not a "end all, be all" power, as emergency powers have their own limitations such as what is and is-not an emergency. Abusing emergency powers is a convictable act which Head of State may become punished for.

<u>Parliament</u>

<u>Referendum and Plebiscite are the two main bodies of Parliament. Referendum</u> consists of all the Hunters within the Hunter's Empire, and Plebiscite consist of appointed Hunters by the Referendum (and sometimes High Council). The Referendum hold opinions then votes for something which is passed onto the Plebiscite who makes the official vote.

<u>High Council</u>

<u>High</u> Council is appointed by Head of State and Plebiscite. High Council acts as Judiciary, delegation between government bodies, representative of Hunters within the Hunter's Empire, and anything not granted to other bodies by the Constitution or Common Law. The High Council may sieze the Head of State should the Head of State disappear.

Breakdown:

Judiciary: Justice, within court, to find Laws constitutional or not.
Delegation: It is unlawful for two bodies to merge or barrow powers from another, High Council may work as an intermediary.
Representing: To represent Hunters of the Hunter's Empire.
"Other": As the Empires grow more duties will be found, until Congress or other government bodies adapts it shall be the High Council to control this "gray area".

<u>Law</u>

<u>The</u> Constitution is the Supreme Law of the Land: the Constitution cannot be challenged by law, Head of State, or any beneath the Constitution. The Constitution may be amended by Parliament. All beneath the Constitution must abide by the Constitution.

<u>C</u>ommon Law is created by Parliament and enacted by the Head of State. Head of State may VETO to which a stronger Parliament may forcibly enact the created Common Law.

Policy

<u>P</u>olicies are directives within a certain jurisdiction which are "rules of land". Policies are below the law and below the three (3) bodies of governments who created them. Policies are local to their designated area as set by the policy.

<u>Policies verses Laws</u>

<u>L</u>aws are of higher order than policies, which much follow laws. Laws are globalized and must treat all equally, policies are localized.

Supreme Law

Supreme Law is the law which is above all else. The Constitution of the Democratic Hunter Empire is the Supreme Law of the Land and all of Hunter's Empire; Head of State isn't above the Supreme Law even with emergency powers (the Constitution explicitly state what is permitted with emergency powers).

Interactions Among the Government

<u>The government's bodies work together to form a unite called a government. The</u> multiple bodies include Head of State, High Council, Parliament; these bodies create Ministries to delegate multiple task, usually outlined in a Policy. Some High Council members unify with Parliament to create laws which are passed onto the Head of State who enacts the law. High Council performs the many task such as Judiciary, Parliament, delegation between bodies and so on.

Unofficial Constitution

<u>The Head of State at times releases unofficial derivatives of the Constitution of</u> the Hunter's Empire, for the public's benefit, which is in no way enforceable.
